Daniel and the Scary Sleepover

Jesus Storybook Bible*: pg. 152-159, from Daniel 6

Memory Verse: "Salvation comes from the Lord." (Jonah 2:9)



Activity: Look at Daniel's the worksheet and ask what thoughts Daniel might have been thinking in the Lion's Den?

Write them in.

Discuss Daniels choice to keep praying to God even when he knew bad things might happen. Do you think Bad things can happen to people if they obey God?



Jesus Connection: Daniel, like Jesus was hated without cause. He was persecuted by high official and people in power. And, his being condemned by the law was a miscarriage of justice. However he too did not protest or accuse those accusing him. Finally think of the surprise when the stone over the lions den was rolled away, just as the Stone over Jesus' "grave".



Prayer: Pray aloud, thanking God that Jesus loved and obeyed even though it meant he would die. Ask God to forgive you and your family when you have not obeyed him and to help us to love and obey him even when it is costly.
