As a Reformed church, we are part of a long and enduring tradition that places worship as our highest calling. Therefore, we lean heavily on those who have gone before and see the value of creeds, catechisms, responsive readings, and other forms that are part of our heritage. However, our services are not highly liturgical, following a fixed pattern, nor spontaneous, but seek to follow a liturgical pattern that reenacts the gospel and renews us in God's grace. Rather than focusing on getting God to bless us, is focuses on the blessings, promises, and grace that we already have in Christ. Our basic gospel pattern is: We approach God based on His initiation and invitation, we see our sin and confess it, we are assured of forgiveness, we hear the good news, and we respond in faith and obedience.

REFLECTION | God's people prepare for worship

"The image the Bible itself often suggests for the way its truth is to be claimed is that of witness. This is an extremely valuable image with which to meet the postmodern suspicion of all metanarratives as oppressive. Witness is non-coercive. It has no power but the convincingness of the truth to which it witnesses. Witnesses are not expected, like lawyers, to persuade by the rhetorical power of speeches, but simply to testify to the truth for which they are qualified to give evidence. . . In our time witness is likely to be the main contender for truth . . ."

All: Praise be to the LORD forever! Amen and Amen.



Leader:

Praise be to our God and Father who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in His Son Christ Jesus. In love, and according to the kind intention of His will, He predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, and through His blood we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he lavished on us.

Yet we confess our indifference toward the lost and acknowledge that we have not done what You have commanded. Give us grace to remember that You will always be with us as we do this day after day, right up to the end of the age. Amen.
