Dear Covenant Family,

## Upcoming Service and Meetings

The church building will be closed, except to staff, until at least Monday, March 30. This includes all services and ministry meetings. We will be recording or streaming a sermon for Sunday, March 22 as well as putting together a worship guide. We will also be sending out our children's church resources to help families worship together.

## Giving

As the church continues to function, many expenses are fixed and continue undeterred by the coronavirus. As well, March is a month when we send out quarterly payments to our mission partners.
