Jesus Storybook Bible": Moses and the Red Sea, from Exodus 14-15

Activity: Give each kid two paper plates. They have to cross the room without falling in the "sea".

Ask: How would you have felt walking between two huge walls of water? **Activity**: Fill in the blank on your activity sheet. Based on this story, the answers are endless. God is...loving, gracious, strong, a rescuer, with us!



Jesus Connection: How does this story point us to Jesus? How does the rescue of the Israelites remind us of our own rescue?
