### God's Wonderful Surprise

**Jesus Storybook Bible\***: pages 310-317, from Matt. 28, Mk. 16, Lk. 24, Jn. 20

**Memory Verse:** "Christ died for sins once for all, to bring you to God." (1 Pet 3:18)

**Activity:** Make a paper crown and write "Jesus is alive!" on the crown.

Decorate it with crayons, stickers, and more.

**Ask:** What happened when the women went to the tomb? Why did Jesus die and come back to life? (Hint: memory verse)

**Activity:** The women spread the news that Jesus was alive! Run around your house and practice shouting, "He's alive! The King is alive!"



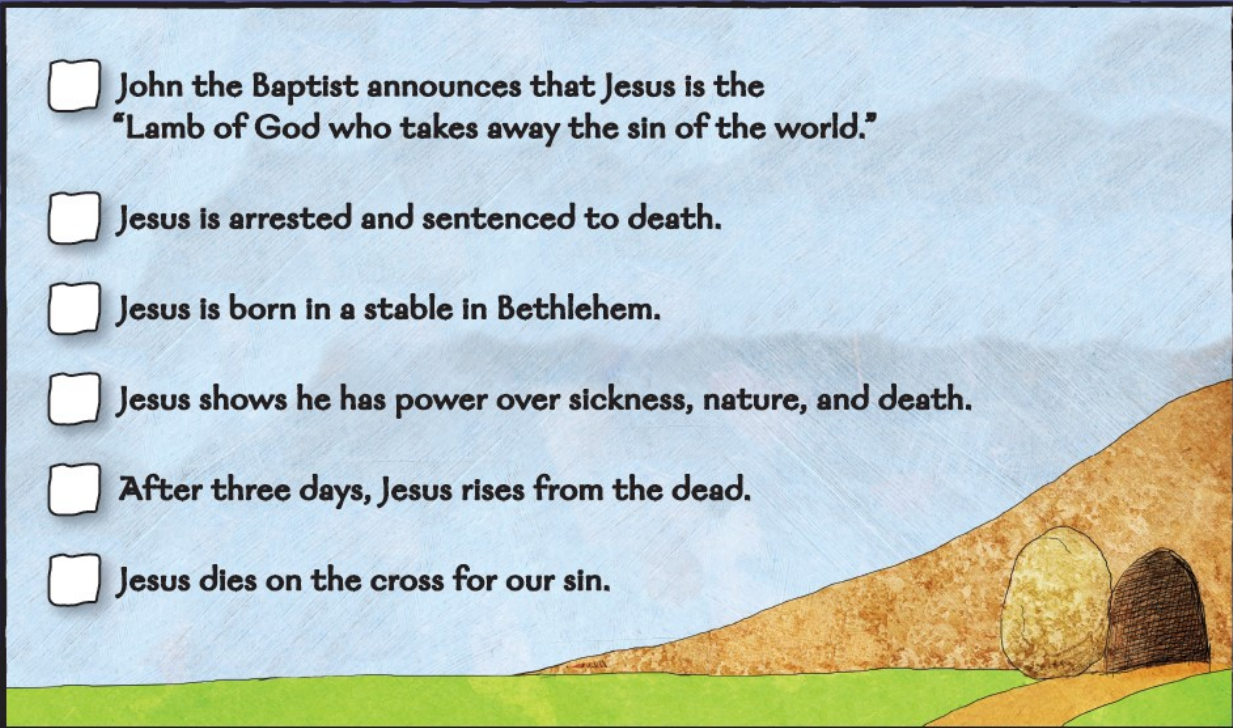
**Jesus Connection:** What do we learn about Jesus from this story? List 5 words to describe Jesus.
