I keep my eyes always on the LORD. I will not be shaken.

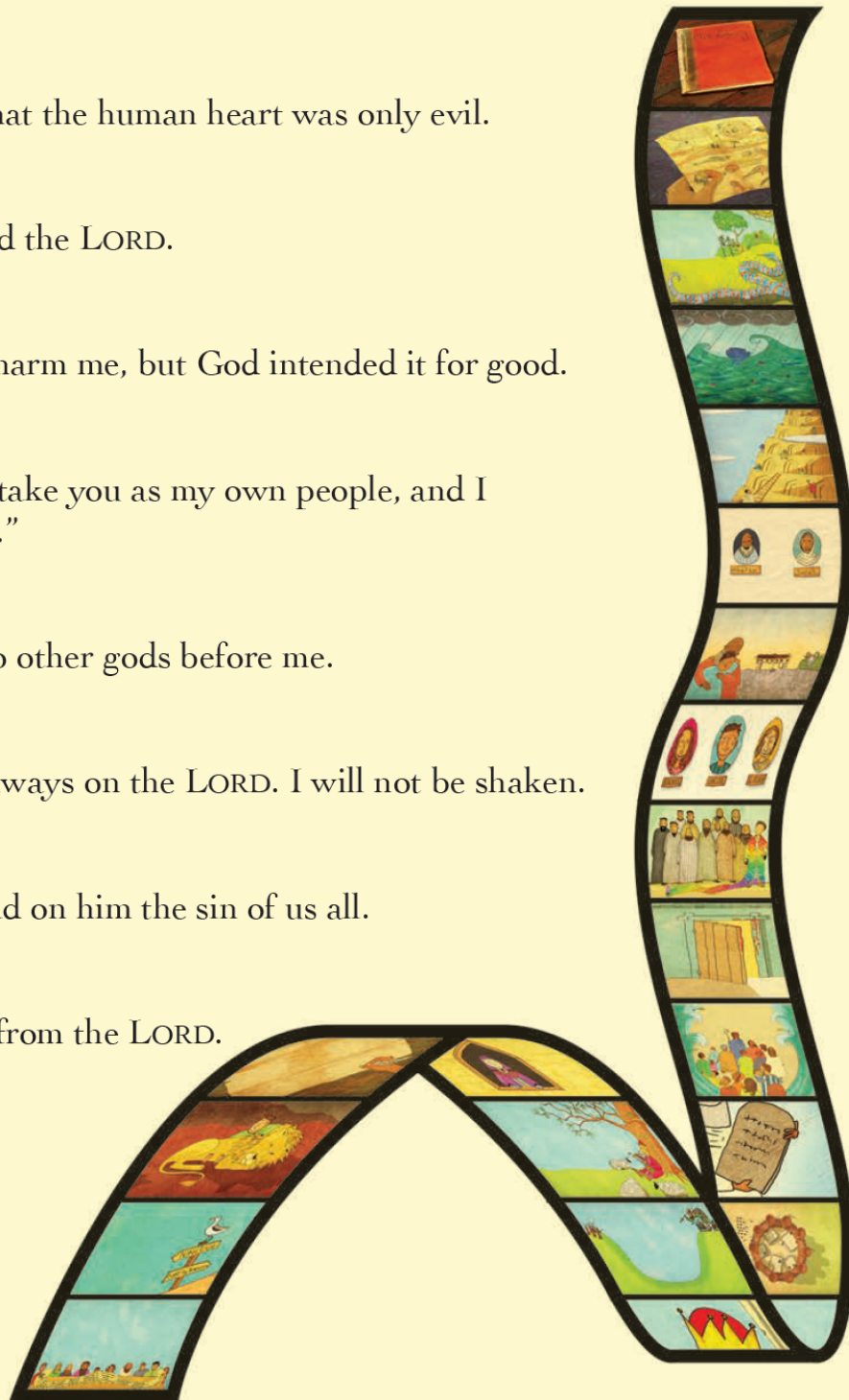
