As a Reformed church, we are part of a long and enduring tradition that places worship as our highest calling. Therefore, we lean heavily on those who have gone before and see the value of creeds, catechisms, responsive readings, and other forms that are part of our heritage. However, our services are not highly liturgical, following a fixed pattern, nor spontaneous, but seek to follow a liturgical pattern that reenacts the gospel and renews us in God's grace. Leader: Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens.


### People: Our God is a God who saves; from the Sovereign Lord comes escape from death.




