As a Reformed church, we are part of a long and enduring tradition that places worship as our highest calling. Therefore, we lean heavily on those who have gone before and see the value of creeds, catechisms, responsive readings, and other forms that are part of our heritage. However, our services are not highly liturgical, following a fixed pattern, nor spontaneous, but seek to follow a liturgical pattern that reenacts the gospel and renews us in God's grace. Rather than focusing on getting God to bless us, is focuses on the blessings, promises, and grace that we already have in Christ. Our basic gospel pattern is: We approach God based on His initiation and invitation, we see our sin and confess it, we are assured of forgiveness, we hear the good news, and we respond in faith and obedience.

make music to our God on the harp.


**All:** Praise the Lord! Psalm 147:1, 5-7, 20c (NIV)



# **RENEWAL** | The Lord forgives his people

**Confessing our Sin** – Confession is a time when we are truly honest with ourselves and God, and because he knows our every thought, there is no need to pretend. Thus we confess our sin and admit that we're not what we should be, nor what we will be.

Gracious Father we confess that we do not live like You are in control of all things and that we cannot "straighten out what You have made crooked." Forgive us for our empty attempts to be in control, and for not finding our rest in You. We confess that we have considered ourselves wiser and more righteous than we truly are. We acknowledge this vanity has left us unfulfilled and weary. 
